**SAFE GROUND RECOMMENDATION:**

To make available, 'Safe Ground', land areas to live, camp, and call home for citizens who choose to live there because of circumstances. 'Safe Ground' areas shall afford all legal rights of residency, such as the right to receive mail. Some 'Safe Ground' areas will include space for vehicles. 'Safe Ground' areas should be open at all times, except for emergency situations. 'Safe Ground' areas should have a, Governance Board, established to act as a liaison between residence of 'Safe Ground' areas and the jurisdiction they reside within, the majority of such board members to be living in a 'Safe Ground' area and voted to be a board member by an election of adults at least eighteen years of age and living in a 'Safe Ground' area within the same jurisdiction for at least the last thirty days before the voting for the board member(s).
